

Art Smart - 3rd Grade
April - Japanese Kimonos

Project Idea: Kimono

Materials Needed:

Kimono template
White Cardstock or heavy paper
Colored pencils, markers
scissors
Optional: hole punch, colored string, glue

Instructions:

Ahead of time, volunteers can make copies or trace kimono outlines on white paper. (There is a front and back shape - students will need one of each) Have students come up with a front and back design for the kimono, paying attention to how the overhang of the back "sleeve" will look from the front view as well. It might be easier for them to cut them out first and then color. Students will color their designs and then can glue them together. If you want, punch a hole and use thread so students can hang their kimonos up and you can see both sides.
