Project Idea: Alexander Calder Animal

Materials Needed:

White paper (Have EXTRA!) Pencil/Erasers Colored Pencils/Crayons/markers

Instructions:

Artist used 1 single piece of wire to create his sculpture "Cow". Students will try to draw an animal of their choice without lifting their hand/pencil off the paper. 1 single line to form all of the animal. They will need to think about how they are going to do that and the details they want to include ahead of time. Let kids use multiple sheets of paper if needed or other side of paper. Have them think about what features they will need to draw to showcase their animal, example elephant - trunk, leopard - spots, etc. When done students can use crayons or colored pencils to color in their animals.
